**AM19/20/003      To receive reports from Community Organisations**

PCSO David Bailey reported that there had been 8 vehicle crimes compared with 5 last year mainly due to vehicle interferences on Simpson Street. There were 2 criminal damage in Hapton compared with 2 in Hapton last year, both connected to the Bridge Inn. There were 7 burglaries, though most were attempted burglaries compared with 6 last year, 4 were business related. 3 thefts and handling compared to 4 last year, 8 assaults, though only 1 in Hapton which was a domestic assault compared to 15 last year but all were in Padiham with none in Hapton. 1 Anti-Social Behaviour report in Hapton, 16 in Padiham compared to 16 with 1 in Hapton last year, mainly cannabis smoking at the back of Simpson Street. Anyone concerned with drug used should contact Crimestoppers and give a report. Motorbikes have quietened down. The Police were thanked for their report.
